What does it cost:

Cost is calculated as follows: \$25 per head per night
Minimum booking is 2 nights or 3 nights on long weekends.
If 6 or more paying guests, organiser stays for free.
Email Deb for bank details, so you can deposit your funds prior to heading over to Gambier.

Please note: Cancellations with less than 48 hours notice will incur a \$50 cancellation fee.

What you need to take:

Bedding: there are 8 single beds/bunks, 2 double beds & a double sofa,
 pillows and blankets/doonas supplied, please take your own linen

Food: There is a barbeque, stove, microwave oven, electric frypan, wok etc.
 (if you use the barbeque in the entrance area, please open the external door, and keep the glass
 door closed)
 Also Cast iron cookpot that works nicely on top of the wood heater.
 On home game nights, meals are available at the football club over the road.

Upon Arrival:

Water: The water should be turned on – however if it is not, you may need to turn on the water & pump –
 the rainwater tank is at the right hand rear of the building, simply turn the lever at the bottom
 45degrees, then turn on the pump at the power point on the wall.
 Check the meter box (on front wall), the hot water switch is on the righthand end – if off, switch
 on, and press boost on the meter above – hot water will be available within approx 30 minutes.

TV/VCR: Turn on at the powerpoint on the wall before use.

DVD The bottom power point has the antenna booster – if reception is poor, try turning this off or on as
 required – usually best to turn on.

Wood Heater: there is a supply of firewood at the left hand end of the building, once you have the fire going,
 you will find it warms the whole building, and if you close down the vent on the front it will keep
 going overnight. If wood is getting low, please let me know so I can order more.

When leaving:

- Please place rubbish in the wheelie bin and place the bin on the far side of the road ready for collection on Sunday night – see schedule on fridge for normal or recycle bin
- Please ensure the fire is out (or dying down) and door securely closed
- Turn off Television and Video at the powerpoint on the wall.
- Ensure No food left in the fridge or rubbish bins inside.
- Lock security doors and external doors.

I hope you have a wonderful stay, and enjoy some fabulous Mt. Gambier diving.
Please advise me of any maintenance requirements as soon as possible.
